Inside an Architectural Sanctuary Ponce-Davis | Miami Hidden within the lush canopy of Ponce-Davis stands a residence that was never built to follow trends only to endure. Designed in the '70s by architect Chayo Frank as his personal home, this 5,000+square foot steel-framed sanctuary was conceived as an environment, not merely a structure. Inspired by the organic philosophy of Frank Lloyd Wright, the home blends geometry, nature, and permanence with rare intention. Exposed structural steel beams form its skeleton, while California redwood wraps the interior and exterior in warmth. Curving 10-foot coral rock walls and expansive glass dissolve boundaries between living space and

while upstairs bedrooms open to a terrace immersed in tropical canopy. A 50 foot inside pool borders coral stone spa. A winding path leads to coral grottos & rare imported plants. A curated ecosystem of extraordinary value. This is not speculative architecture. A steel and wood sanctuary that can't be replicated. it is rare to encounter a masterpiece of this magnitude and rarer still to offer a sanctuary like this to the one person capable of truly becoming one with it.
